REQUIRE A RECORDED VOTE TO INCREASE THE CEILING OF THE FEDERAL DEBT

WHEREAS, inflation is destroying the American economy and way of life: and

WHEREAS, a fundamental cause of inflation is deficit spending by the federal government; and

WHEREAS, Congress has been unwilling to effectively or consistently control deficit spending;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the National Association of Home Builders urges Congress to adopt rules to require a recorded vote in both Houses whenever voting on a resolution to increase the ceiling of the federal debt.
