Title: Housing Data
Original Sponsor: Standing Committee on Long Range Planning

WHEREAS, a reliable data base is fundamental in farming housing legislation;

WHEREAS, data on housing production, the housing stock and housing costs are used in the administration of a wide variety of federal housing programs;

WHEREAS, state and local government agencies make decisions regarding infrastructure, land use and other vital issues based on data from the federal government;

WHEREAS, federal government data are important to the efficiency and productivity of private industry; and

WHEREAS, the ability of households to find affordable housing that meets their needs depends on well-informed decisions by private producers, state and local government agencies and the federal government,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the federal government maintain and improve the scope and quality of data related to housing and housing finance that it collects and disseminates.
